## Class Descriptions

### TOT HOCKEY

For new players ages 3-5 with no skating experience. Class will teach standing, falling & getting up, balance, forward & backward skating and introducing how to hold their stick. The goal of tot hockey is to give new players sound skating fundamentals.

### HOCKEY 1

For players who have completed Tot Hockey or are age 6 and up. This class will continue to teach skating technique along with proper skating stance, forward stride, stops, and basic stick handling and puck movement drills.

### HOCKEY 2 & 3

For players who have completed Tot Hockey or are age 6 and up. This class will continue to teach skating technique along with proper skating stance, forward stride, stops, and basic stick handling and puck movement drills.

### HOCKEY 4

Players will learn positions and the rules of the game. Players will have the chance to play 2 on 2 or 3 on 3 while learning to take face offs & playing various positions.
